Suggested answers

Synonyms are in **bold**.

Your first question

My first question is how much it costs. = First, can you tell me what the price would be?

First of all, I'd like to ask how much it **weighs**. = To start with, I need to know how **heavy** it is.

First off, could you tell me its **size**? = Firstly, please tell me what its **dimensions** are.

Your second question

I'd also like to know what it **looks like**. = I also have a question about its **appearance**.

My second question is how long we have to pay. = Next, would you mind telling me what the payment terms are?

Could I also ask what **amount of electricity** it will use? = The next thing I would like to know is its **power consumption**.

The last of the three questions on the list

Last of all, I have a question about what support there will be after I purchase it. = Finally, can you tell me what after sales service there is?

Additional questions

I do have just one more question. Is there a **warrantee**? = Can I ask for some more information on that point? How long is the **guarantee** for?

Before we finish, I have one additional question. Is it **ecologically friendly**? = Can you give me some additional information about how **green** it is?

- Say one and see if your partner can say another indirect question with the same meaning, changing the wording as much as possible
- Change one into a direct question like "How long do we have to pay?" and see if your partner can change it into a suitable indirect question
