

Want plus prepositions of position personalised drawing game

Pick one of the cards below and draw that thing, with the desired thing in a thought bubble to show that the person or animal wants to do that and is not doing it now. Don't show your card to your partner. Your partner will try to guess the sentence that you have drawn. When they guess that correctly, they should then guess if you want to do that thing or not.

Useful phrases for the personalised guessing stage

"I think that you want..."

"I think that you don't want..."

"That's true."

"That's not true. I..."

Share one thing that your partner wants and see if anyone else in the class wants to same thing.

Ask about any cards you don't understand, etc, guessing if other people want that each time.

Change groups. Make guesses about your partner with want and prepositions, without the cards to help.
